

MONITORING OF CASES

Parties are responsible for monitoring cases as to their status - i.e., whether cases are open or closed, have been dismissed and are awaiting closing orders, etc. In particular, if something requiring payment of a fee is filed (motion for relief from stay, e.g.) in a case which has been dismissed but is not yet closed, the filing fee will NOT be refunded in the event that the action is marked off calendar.

The Court's **PACER** and **VCIS** systems, described elsewhere at this site, are recommended as effective means of monitoring the status of cases.
