Waiver of Electronic Access Fee for Chapter 13 Trustees

IN THAT the Miscellaneous Fee Schedule of Title 28 U.S.C., Section 1930 requires the Clerk of Court to charge a fee for electronic accessing of information on this Court's Case and Claims Dockets and

IN THAT the United States Judicial Conference has authorized the local court to waive the fee for certain groups including the trustees appointed in the bankruptcy process and

IN THAT the Board of Judges of the Bankruptcy Court in the Eastern District of New York has authorized the waiving of the fee for trustees appointed in cases proceeding under Chapter 13 of Title 11 of the United States Code; it is hereby

ORDERED that the fee prescribed in this Miscellaneous Fee Schedule for electronic access to Court docketing and claims is hereby waived for all Trustees appointed in Chapter 13 cases only, and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of Court complete the appropriate noticing and administrative requirements implementing this Order
