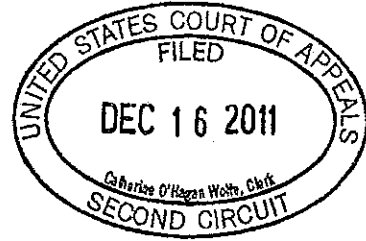

ORDER

UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY  
JUDGE


WHEREAS it has been determined by this Judicial Council that the services of a retired bankruptcy judge are needed for the Eastern District of New York, and

WHEREAS **Joel B. Rosenthal** has retired from service and has consented to serve as a recalled bankruptcy judge pursuant to the regulations promulgated by the Judicial Conference of the United States,

IT IS ORDERED pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §155(b) that **Joel B. Rosenthal** is recalled into service as a United States Bankruptcy Judge in the Eastern District of New York, for a term effective December 31, 2011 through February 28, 2012.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **Joel B. Rosenthal** shall receive the salary of a full-time bankruptcy judge subject to the restrictions on the payment of an annuity in subchapter III of Chapter 83 of Title 5 of the United States Code, and shall be entitled to appoint a secretary and law clerk subject to the availability of funds.
