## **REASONS FOR THIS REQUEST**

4. The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (the "CARES Act") was
enacted on March 27, 2020. The CARES Act adds Section 1329(d) to the Bankruptcy Code for
a limited period (extended to March 27, 2022 pursuant to The Covid-19 Bankruptcy Relief
Extension Act of 2021). This Section permits a debtor to request a modification to a Chapter 13
plan that was confirmed before March 27, 2020, if he or she has experienced material financial
hardship caused, directly or indirectly, by the COVID-19 pandemic.
5. I have experienced material financial hardship caused by the COVID-19 pandemic as follows:
