WHEREAS, the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts having further amended Form B240A, Reaffirmation Documents, effective April 2010, it is hereby

ORDERED, that Administrative Order #545 be and is hereby abrogated, and it is further

ORDERED, that effective immediately, Procedural Form B240A, Reaffirmation Documents, dated April 2010 will be required for use in this District in the memorializing of any agreement between the debtor and a creditor to repay a debt pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 524(c); and, it is further

ORDERED, that any subsequent amendments as may be made from time to time by the Administrative Office will be required for use in this Court without further order of the Court, and it is further

ORDERED, that the Clerk of Court is directed to make this form available on the Court's Internet site and at the Clerk's Office at each Court location.
