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ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE TO CLIENTS

WHEREAS, Dean Weber ("Weber"), by order dated December 20, 2012, was suspended from the practice of law before the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York (the "First EDNY Suspension Order"); and

WHEREAS, the First EDNY Suspension Order was to become effective 24 days after the date of service upon Weber, unless otherwise modified or stayed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Rule 2090-1(a) of the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of New York, an attorney who may practice in the District Court pursuant to Civil Rule 1.3 of the Local District Rules may practice in this Court, and conversely, an attorney who has been suspended by the District Court is also suspended from practicing in this Court; and

WHEREAS, on January 24, 2013, this Court issued General Order No. 604 requiring Weber, within fourteen days of entry of that order, to give the notice required by 22 NYCRR § 691.10(d)(1) and (3), and in the manner set forth therein, to any client for whom he has appeared in a case or adversary proceeding currently pending in this Court, to any attorney for each adverse party in such adversary proceeding or in any contested matter in any such case, to any chapter 7 or chapter 13 trustee in that case, and to the United States Trustee, and to promptly file a copy of each such notice on the electronic docket of the case or adversary proceeding to which it pertains; and

WHEREAS, General Order No. 604 also revoked Weber's attorney password for access to the Court's Electronic Case Filing System on the effective date of the First EDNY Suspension Order; and

WHEREAS, by order dated January 31, 2013, the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York stayed the First EDNY Suspension Order until February 21, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on February 7, 2013, this Court issued General Order No. 605 staying General Order No. 604 until February 21, 2013; and

WHEREAS, by order dated March 4, 2013, Weber was suspended from the practice of law before the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York effective immediately;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED, that the stay provided by General Order 605 is hereby terminated; and it is further

ORDERED, that in addition to any other obligations imposed upon Weber by any court order, statute, rule or regulation relating to his suspension, Weber shall, within seven days after the entry of this order give the notice required by 22 NYCRR § 691.10(d)(1) and (3), and in the manner set forth therein, to any client for whom he has appeared in a case or adversary proceeding currently pending in this Court, to any attorney for each adverse party in such adversary proceeding or in any contested matter in any such case, to any chapter 7 or chapter 13 trustee in that case, and to the United States Trustee, and shall promptly file a copy of each such notice on the docket of the case or adversary proceeding to which it pertains; and it is further

ORDERED, that Weber's attorney password for access to the Court's Electronic Case Filing System is revoked immediately; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Clerk of Court is directed to serve this order upon Weber.
