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WHEREAS, Local Bankruptcy Rule 5001-1 permits the electronic filing of Proofs of Claim, and

WHEREAS, the Court is implementing an Electronic Proof of Claim system (“ePOC”) that permits the electronic filing of proofs of claim, amended proofs of claim, withdrawal of proofs of claim, and claim supplements (FRBP 3002.1 mortgage payment documents: Notice of Mortgage Payment Change; Notice of Postpetition Mortgage Fees, Expenses, and Charges; and Response to Notice of Final Cure Payment), it is hereby

ORDERED, that proofs of claim may be filed, amended, withdrawn and supplemented through ePOC without the need to obtain a CM/ECF login and password except in cases where the Court has appointed a Claims and Noticing Agent, and it is further

ORDERED, that any claim filed, amended, withdrawn or supplemented through ePOC shall constitute the filer’s approved signature and have the same force and effect as if the individual signed a paper copy of such document, and it is further

ORDERED, that a claim filed through ePOC is considered the original proof of claim.
