**EDNY & GSA Celebrate Permanent Installation of Landmarks of NY Exhibit**

Chief Judge Dora L. Irizarry of the United States District Court and Chief Bankruptcy Judge Carla Craig of the Eastern District of New York jointly announced that, on Thursday, October 5th, the Eastern District of New York and the General Services Administration will sponsor a program to celebrate the permanent installation of the 95-photograph exhibit, *Landmarks of New York*, in the Conrad B. Duberstein United States Bankruptcy Courthouse. The exhibit is a gift from Dr. Barbaralee Diamonstein-Spielvogel, author of *The Landmarks of New York*, and the curator of the exhibit.

Attendees are invited to preview the exhibit at 5:00 p.m. in advance of the program which commences at 5:30 p.m. in the second floor courtroom at the Duberstein Courthouse, 271-C Cadman Plaza East in downtown Brooklyn. In addition to the two EDNY judges, speakers include Chief Circuit Judge Robert A. Katzmann, Dean Matthew Diller of Fordham Law School, and Acting GSA Region 2 Commissioner Darren Gomez.

Chief Bankruptcy Judge Carla Craig stated, "The permanent installation of this impressive exhibit depicting 95 New York landmarks, some of which are lost forever, in this historic landmarked Romanesque Revival federal courthouse signifies the important intersection of private and public partnerships by which we bring our federal courthouses into the community and bring the communities we serve into our federal spaces. We join with Chief Judges Katzmann and Irizarry in thanking Dr. Diamonstein-Spielvogel for her generous gift to the GSA and the federal courts here in Brooklyn."

The *Landmarks of New York* program will be followed by a reception in the second floor atrium of the Duberstein Courthouse. All are invited to attend this program and the post- program reception.
